Students of age may receive one-on-one training with an instructor if such training is agreed to by the parent or guardian. The student is required to meet the observation requirements with at least one other student in the vehicle during in-vehicle training.

Normally, there are 2 students in the car, each driving and observing a 50-minute session. Occasionally with parental permission, a third student can join 2 students during the last observation period. The third student would observe for 50 minutes and then the original 2 students would be taken home. The third student would remain with the instructor and drive for 50 minutes. This option for Behind-the-Wheel is helpful for students with time constraints because of athletics, extracurricular activities, school, travel, or work. Also when there are long waiting lists, an instructor can drive with 3 students after school instead of 2. Parents should only sign permission if they want their child to have this option.

Due to the possibility of fluctuating gas prices, I understand that a surcharge may be added to the quoted price for Behind-the-Wheel instruction.
