

DMV SERVICE CONTRACT FOR 17 AND UNDER

Course instruction does not guarantee that any student will pass the state license examination, or that the student can secure a license, or that the student will be guaranteed employment upon completion of any course instruction. Tuition is non-refundable unless the school or instructor is unable or unwilling to perform its part of the contract within 30 calendar days from the date agreed to in the contract. A paid student may repeat a failed class within one year free of charge.



- Fees to be paid upon registration.
- Students 17 years of age and under are required to complete all Drivers Education.
- Students will be notified in the event of cancellations. Rescheduling will be made at that time.
- Any missed classes/assignments must be made up in subsequent classes. There are no additional fees.

"It is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian, to report to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) any concerns regarding school facilities, instructor behavior, or quality of instruction by the school. The DMV is committed to promoting transportation safety through the certification of quality driver training programs. Students aged 17 or under may receive one-on-one training with an instructor if such training is agreed to by the parent or guardian. The student is required to meet the observation requirements with at least one other student in the road evaluation.

Normally, there are two students in the car each driving and observing a 50-minute session. With parental permission, a third student can join during the last observation period. The third student would observe for 50 minutes and then the original two students would be dismissed. The third student would remain with the instructor and drive for 50 minutes. This road evaluation option is helpful for students with time constraints due to school, school athletics, school extracurricular activities, travel, or work. When there are long waiting lists, an instructor can drive with three students after school instead of two. Parents should only sign permission if they want their child to have this option.

Due to the possibility of fluctuating gas prices, I understand that a fuel surcharge may be added to the quoted price for the Road Evaluation.

I understand the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the legal administrative duties of the Department of Motor Vehicles, and their requirements in regards to driver education.
